The Race Director, having received a report from the Stewards, has considered the following matter and determine the following:

Fact	Driver of Car 2 was significantly flanking Car 95 on the S/F straight, while a tiny wheel-to-wheel contact caused the car in front to unvoluntarily steer to the left, causing the crash, in which the other car was forced to retire.
Offence	Alleged breach of article 4.1-2 of ATOM Sporting Regulations
Decision	No further action
Reason	<p>The Stewards noted the incident and judged that Driver of Car 2 was not at fault for the major incident, because he was recognizing the contact with Car 95, but as Car 95 (which had space to avoid the touch) did not use all the track, the rear-left wheel of Car 2 was involved in an instant turning action, unwanted and unpredicted, which caused the terminal situation.</p> <p>Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 9.6 of the R&R and Article 1 of the Appendix A of the R&R, within the applicable time limits.</p>
