The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, after consulting with him, they have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver	34 - Luca Rondelli
Competitor	Alfa Romeo

Session	Race
Fact	The driver of Car 34 collided with Car 74 at Turn 13 in lap 19.
Offence	Alleged breach of Article 17.11 of the ATOM F1 2021 Regulations
Decision	No Further Action
Reason	The Stewards noted that Car 34 was attempting to overtake on the inside of Car 74 in turn 13. Due to the minimal space, Car 74 rightfully left enough space for such a manoeuvre but both cars collided and the approaching car was spun round. Upcoming cars could not avoid a collision due to the compact gaps in between the Drivers.

The Stewards always check where there is space to avoid a potential incident, and despite the yellow flags, judge that no driver would have been able to avoid the pileup.

Finally, The Stewards judge that nobody shall be at fault for the collision, due to the fact that the incident's outcome was the result of an unfortunate event, and also because both drivers took a reasonable effort to mitigate the effect of the collision.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with articles 32.8 and 32.9 of the ATOM F1 2021 Regulations, within 7 days. Penalties given in the race are not subject to

appeal (Article 32.10, issue 3 of the Code).
