The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter, and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 29 - Francesco Clemente

**Competitor** Williams F1

**Time** 22:08

**Session** Practice, Qualifying, Race

**Fact** Dangerous and Unsportsmanship Driving

**Offence** Breach of Articles 17.11 and 17.14 of ATOM Regulations

**Decision** Disqualification from the Race

**Reason** Reported by the Race Director, the Stewards followed the driving behaviour of car 29 (CLE) during the Qualifying and Race sessions as the competitor driving was reported to be dangerous.

After the Race, the whole McLaren F1 Team provided to the Race Director some footage in which the driver's conduct was risky and unsafe for the other cars on track.

Reviewing the footage and with the considerations of the Stewards, the driver seemed to not be able to conduct the vehicle in a safe manner.

For this reason, the Stewards deemed appropriate to disqualify the Driver from the race.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with articles 32.8 and 32.9 of the ATOM F1 22 Regulations, within 7 days.
