The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 15 - Simone Gallo

Competitor Ferrari

Time 21:28

Session Qualifying

Fact The driver changed his line allegedly unpredictably before turn 1 for giving a tow to his teammate.

Offence Alleged breach of article 4.1.4 of ATOM Sporting Regulations (Art. 4.9.4.1.4 of ATOM R&R)

Decision **No further action.**

Reason The Stewards, received a report at 21:28:12 from the Race Director, reviewed the video evidences and decided to examine the incident.

They concluded that the driver Gallo was rightfully steering right to leave the braking zone to his teammate, in a way considered legitimate and definitely not unpredictable.

The chosen spot could have been dangerous because at that time a Williams car was exiting the pit lane, but despite all of them being close to each other, all the three cars did comply with the gentlemen's rules of racing.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with Article 9.6 of the ATOM R&R and Article 1 of the Appendix A of the ATOM R&R, within the applicable time limits.
