The Stewards, having received a report from the Race Director, after consulting with him, they have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No / Driver 21 - Alessandro Granzella

Competitor Alpha Tauri

Session Race

Fact The Driver of Car 21 did not brake in time and collided with Car 46 at Turn 1.

The Driver then left the track and while re-joining made contact with the same

other car, causing a massive pileup of cars and leading to a crash.

Offence Breach of articles 17.11 and 17.14 of the ATOM F1 2021 Regulations.

Decision The Driver is required to start the next Race from the back of the grid (4 points

imposed on Driver's Super Licence, total of 6 in the 12-month period)

(Penalty evolved from a 10-second Stop/Go Penalty given in the Race at 22:12

because of the Driver's retirement)

Reason The driver was at fault for the collision(s) quoted above.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with articles 32.8 and 32.9 of the ATOM F1

2021 Regulations, within 7 days.
