The Stewards, hearing from the Race Director, considered the following matter and determine the following:

**No / Driver** 97 - Dennis Salerno

**Competitor** Alpha Tauri

**Session** Race

**Fact** During lap 31, car 97 collided with car 37. Both cars spun and retired.

**Offence** Breach of Articles 17.11 and 17.14 of the ATOM Regulations

**Decision** The Driver is disqualified from the Race Results according to Article 32.2.8 of The ATOM Regulations and The Driver is subject to a 1-race ban according to Article 32.2.9 not consequent to Super Licence suspension (5 points imposed on Driver's Super Licence, total of 11 in the 12-month period)

**Reason** The video evidence(s) submitted revealed that Car 97 was unquestionably to blame for the collision.

As the collision was fairly avoidable, The Stewards are imposing a harder penalty to the Driver.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards, in accordance with articles 32.8 and 32.9 of the ATOM F1 2021 Regulations, within 7 days.
