| | After the Race, the whole Mclaren F1 Team provided to the Race Director some footage in which the driver's conduct was risky and unsafe for the other cars on track. | | |
| | Reviewing the footage and with the considerations of the Stewards, the driver seemed to not be able to conduct the vehicle in a safe manner. | | |
| | For this reason, the Stewards deemed appropriate to disqualify the Driver from the race. | | |
